






❖ Calculation of Body mass Index (BMI) on 15.02.2022

Calculated body mass index of all girl students in the college to know the physical strength of girls. BMI is used as the primary indicator of physical health worldwide.






Awareness Program on Women Health and Hygiene on 17.02.2022

Impairment: Any loss or abnormality of psychological, physiological, or anatomical structure or function.

Disability: Any restriction or lack of ability to perform an activity in the manner or within the range considered normal for a human being.

Handicap: A disadvantage for a given individual, resulting from an impairment or disability, that limits or prevents the fulfilment of a role that is normal, depending on age, sex, social and cultural factors, for that individual.

The Practice:

Through our 'Enabling the disabled' we are planning to do one social service activity per month. In this part we find the disabled people who have not any support from their family members and orphans and serve worth Rs.500/- Provisions for them.

4. Constraints & Limitations:


