- Apart from academic knowledge and skills, it is necessary for the students to understand social responsibility and the need for serving the marginalized groups in the society.
- Feeling social responsibility and putting it into practice is one of graduate attributes.

3. The Context

The world is globalized and disasters have no barriers. The world has witnessed pandemics like covid-19. Many families lost their dear ones. Millions of children became orphans. and many more suffered from lack of ready medicines and medical support at the right time. UNICEF takes care of such destitute children without any barriers. Hence, it is felt appropriate to enlighten the students on the activities of UNICEF and motivate them to help at global level.

4. The Practice

Each class with about 50 students has decided to donate 500/- per month to UNICEF (that means each student contributes 10/- per month). The donation is paid online under the

guidance and monitoring of the teacher concerned and the receipt document is saved for future reference.

Constraints & Limitations:

Some classes have fewer than 20 students. As it is a constraint, such classes will contribute 500/- in 3 months. During summer vacation, it becomes difficult to collect and donate.

5. Evidence of Success

Some students shared a few other contexts in which they voluntarily helped the needy in their neighborhood as they were motivated by this Best Practice. Thus they grew compassionate and it was reflected in their shared experiences.

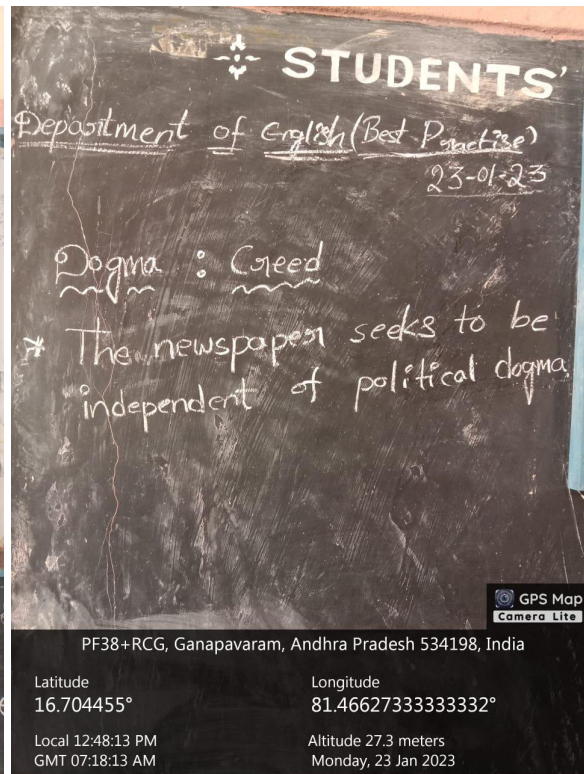
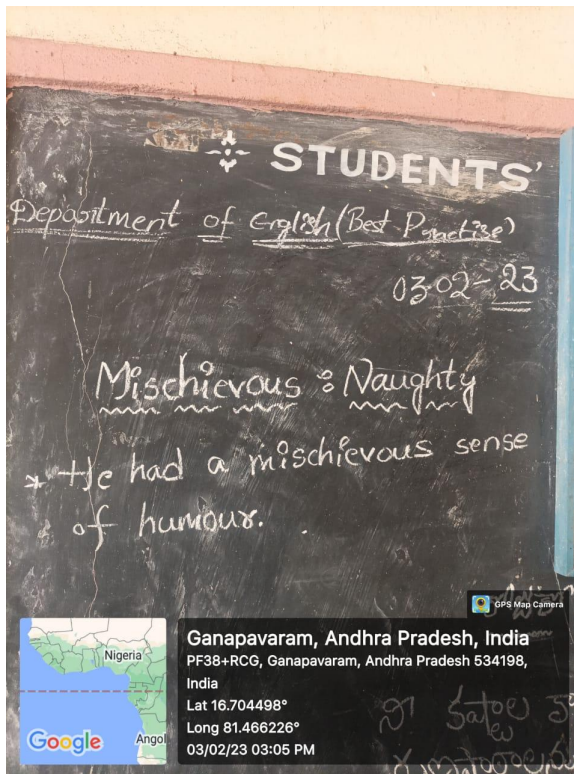

Impairment: Any loss or abnormality of psychological, physiological, or anatomical structure or function.

Disability: Any restriction or lack of ability to perform an activity in the manner or within the range considered normal for a human being.

Handicap: A disadvantage for a given individual, resulting from an impairment or disability, that limits or prevents the fulfilment of a role that is normal, depending on age, sex, social and cultural factors, for that individual.

The Practice:

Through our '**Enabling the disabled**' we are planning to do one social service activity per month. In this part we find the disabled people who have not any support from their family members and orphans and serve worth **Rs.500/-** Provisions for them.

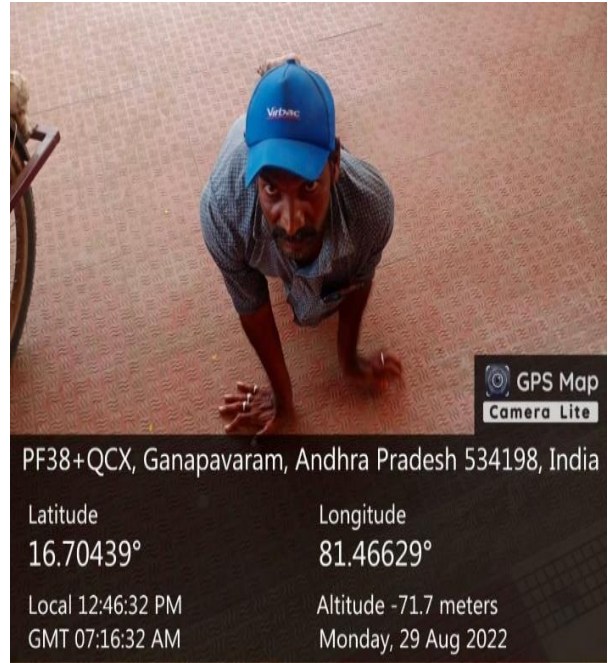
