The Remedial coaching classes were conducted by the Department of Physics for slow learners in the UG program at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College, Ganapavaram. The program aimed to help students who were struggling to keep up with the pace of regular classes and improve their understanding of fundamental concepts in physics.

**Objectives:** The primary objectives of the Remedial coaching classes were to improve the understanding of basic concepts, enhance problem-solving skills, and increase the confidence of students who were struggling with physics. The program was also designed to help students catch up with their peers and excel in their coursework.

**Methodology:** The remedial coaching classes were conducted through interactive lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on exercises. The instructors used various teaching strategies, such as analogies, real-life examples, and visual aids, to help students understand complex concepts. The instructors also provided one-on-one support to students who needed additional help.

**Results:** The remedial coaching classes were attended by a total of 19 students, and the program was conducted from 9-7-2018 to 3-8-2018. The results of the program were positive, with students showing significant improvements in their understanding of basic concepts in physics. The students who participated in the program demonstrated better problem-solving skills and greater confidence in their ability to learn physics. Moreover, the attendance rate of the participants improved significantly compared to the regular classes.

**Discussion:** The results of the remedial coaching classes suggest that such programs can be effective in helping slow learners catch up with their peers and improve their academic performance. The interactive and hands-on approach of the program was particularly helpful in engaging students who were struggling with physics. However, future programs could be improved by incorporating more personalized

learning strategies and by tailoring the program to meet the individual needs of each student.

Conclusion: The remedial coaching classes conducted by the Department of Physics for slow learners at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College, Ganapavaram were successful in achieving their objectives of helping students improve their understanding of basic concepts, enhancing problem-solving skills, and increasing their confidence. The program's results suggest that such initiatives can be beneficial for students who are struggling academically, and further efforts should be made to develop and improve similar programs to support students in their learning journey.

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**5. Student seminar** : The Department of Physics at S CH V P M R Government Degree College in Ganapavaram organized a student seminar on the topic of LCR Series Circuits on 21st January 2019. The seminar aimed to enhance the knowledge of BSC Physics students about LCR circuits and their applications.

#### **1. Bridge Course:**

**Date: Bridge Course June-19,20,21, 22, 23, 24, 29&July 02-2018**

The bridge course classes for UG students on Telugu subject was conducted at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College Ganapavaram from **Bridge Course June-19,20,21, 22, 23, 24,29&July 02-2018**

The course was designed to provide a comprehensive understanding of fundamental concepts of Telugu Language and Literature to the students, who are transitioning from intermediate to Degree College. The course aimed to enhance the students' basic knowledge, skills and to bridge the gap between their Intermediate and undergraduate level knowledge.

#### **Methodology:**

The course was designed in such a way that it covered various topics such as Telugu Alphabets, Words, Grammar, Basics of Literature, Literary Forms Classical Modern Literature, Poetry Prose, Novel, Short Story, drama Criticism etc.

#### **Recommendations:**


