#### STUDENT SEMINAR: 30-07-2018, 22-01-2019



#### STUDENT QUIZ COMPETITION:



The Remedial coaching classes were conducted by the Department of Physics for slow learners in the UG program at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College, Ganapavaram. The program aimed to help students who were struggling to keep up with the pace of regular classes and improve their understanding of fundamental concepts in physics.

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3.Quiz: date 12-7-2018

#### 3. JAM Session:




#### 6. JAM Session:


