2. Remedial coaching:

The Remedial coaching classes were conducted by the Department of Mathematics for slow learners in the UG program at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College, Ganapavaram. The program aimed to help students who were struggling to keep up with the pace of regular classes and improve their understanding of fundamental concepts in mathematics. **Objectives:** The primary objectives of the Remedial coaching classes were to improve the understanding of basic concepts, enhance problem-solving skills, and increase the

confidence of students who were struggling with mathematics. The program was also designed to help students catch up with their peers and excel in their coursework.

Methodology: The remedial coaching classes were conducted through interactive lectures, demonstrations, and hands-on exercises. The instructors used various teaching strategies, such as analogies, real-life examples to help students understand complex concepts. The instructors also provided one-on-one support to students who needed additional help.

Results: The remedial coaching classes were attended by a total of 19 students, and the program was conducted from 15-7-2019 to 24-8-2019. The results of the program were positive, with students showing significant improvements in their understanding of basic concepts in Mathematics. The students who participated in the program demonstrated better problem-solving skills and greater confidence in their ability to learn mathematics. Moreover, the attendance rate of the participants improved significantly compared to the regular classes.

Discussion: The results of the remedial coaching classes suggest that such programs can be effective in helping slow learners catch up with their peers and improve their academic performance. The interactive and hands-on approach of the program was particularly helpful in engaging students who were struggling with mathematics. However, future programs could be improved by incorporating more personalized learning strategies and by tailoring the program to meet the individual needs of each student.

Conclusion: The remedial coaching classes conducted by the Department of Mathematics for slow learners at S Ch V P M R Government Degree College, Ganapavaram were successful in achieving their objectives of helping students improve their understanding of basic concepts, enhancing problem-solving skills, and increasing their confidence. The program's results suggest that such initiatives can be beneficial for students who are struggling

academically, and further efforts should be made to develop and improve similar programs to support students in their learning journey.

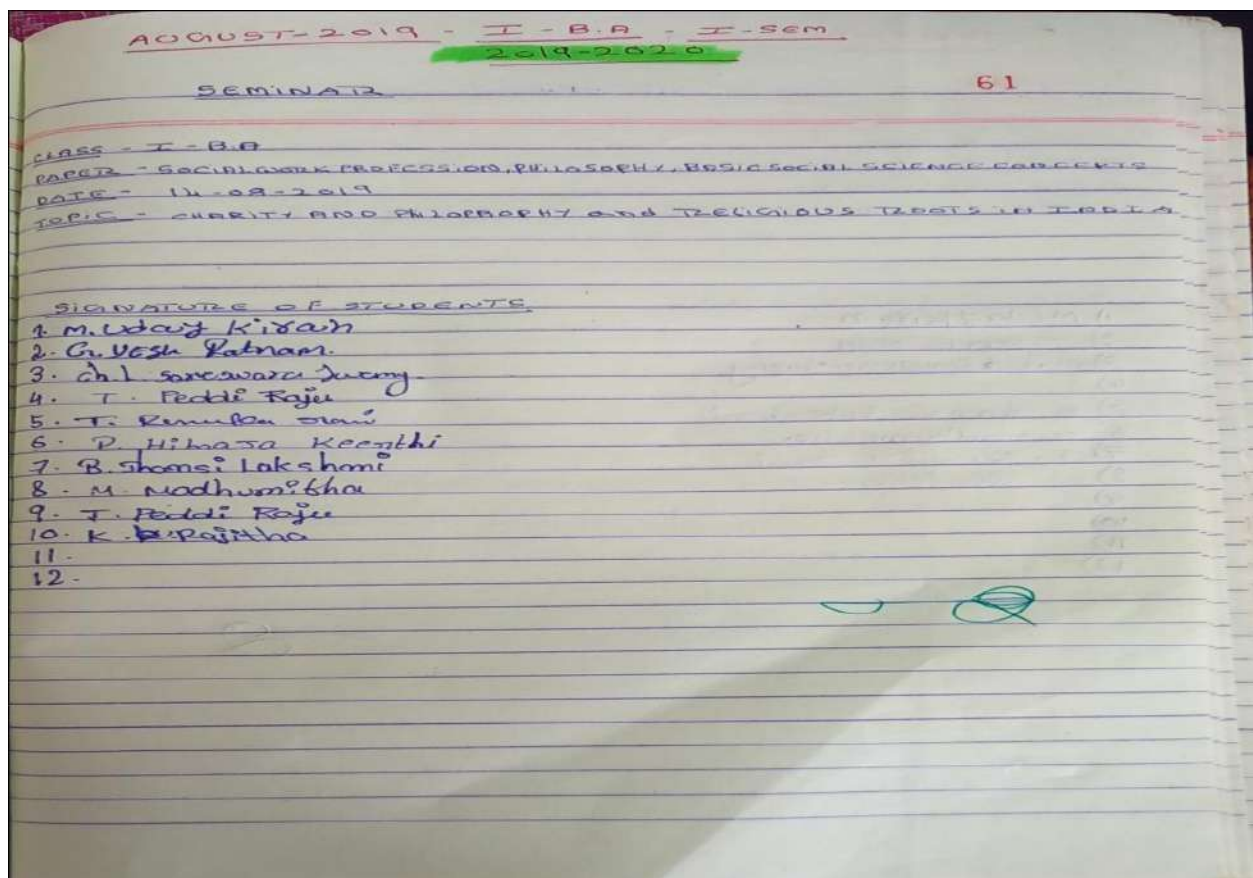

The department of social work conducted a student seminar. The social work students participate in class room seminar input of the society principles and scope.

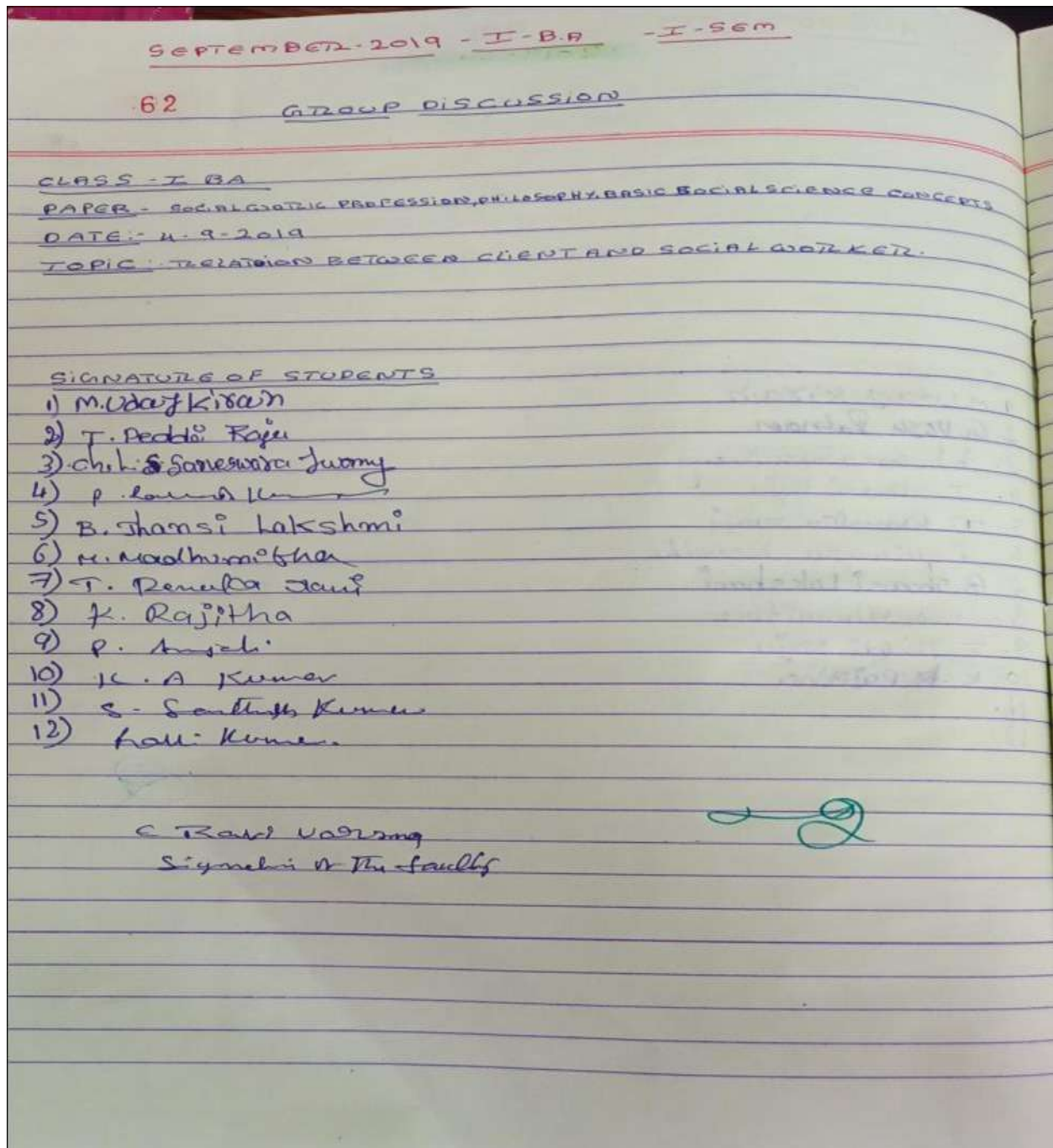


3. Group discussion on relation between client and social worker I BA : 04-09-2019

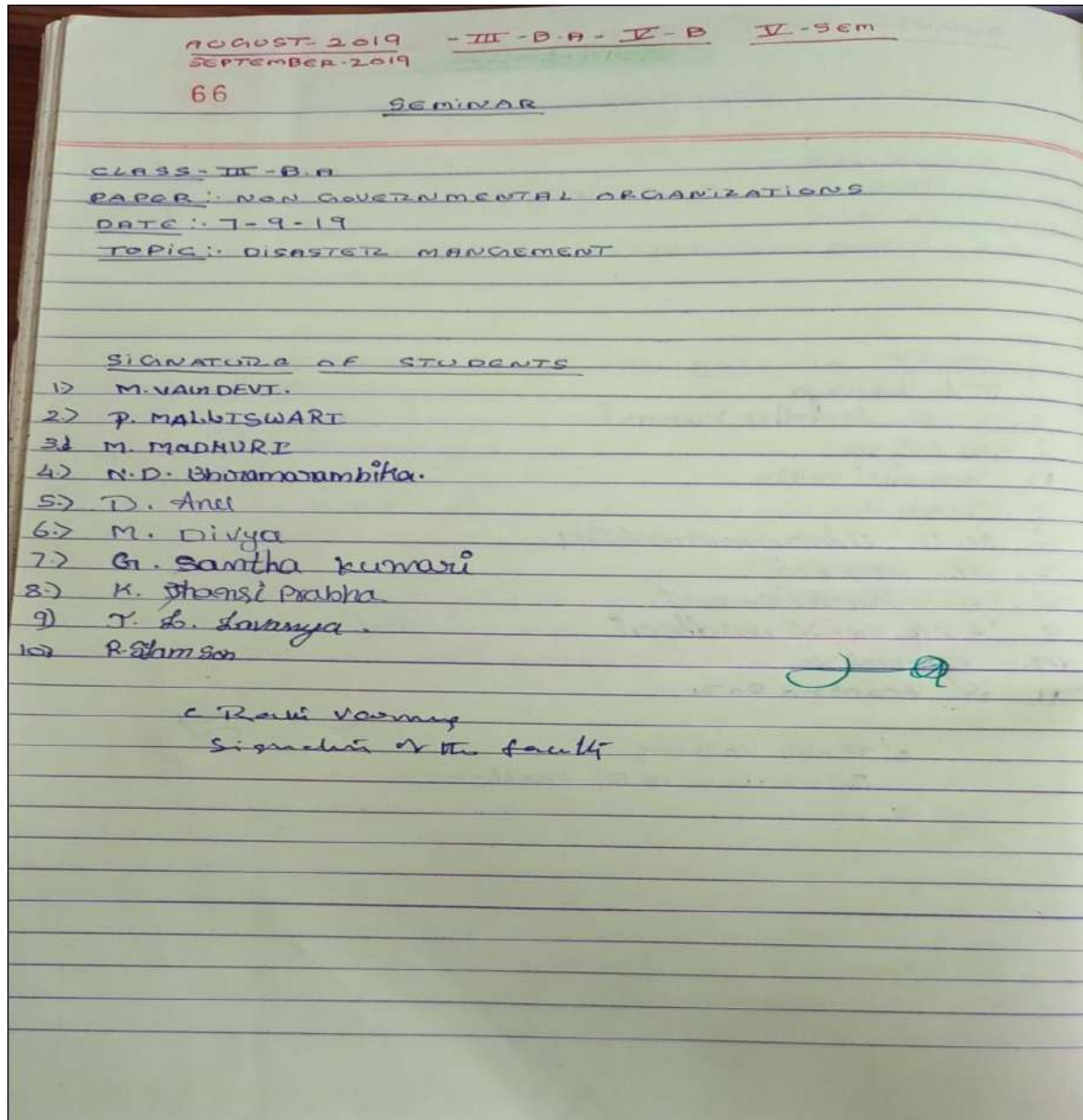


4. Students seminar on disaster management III BA : 07.09.19

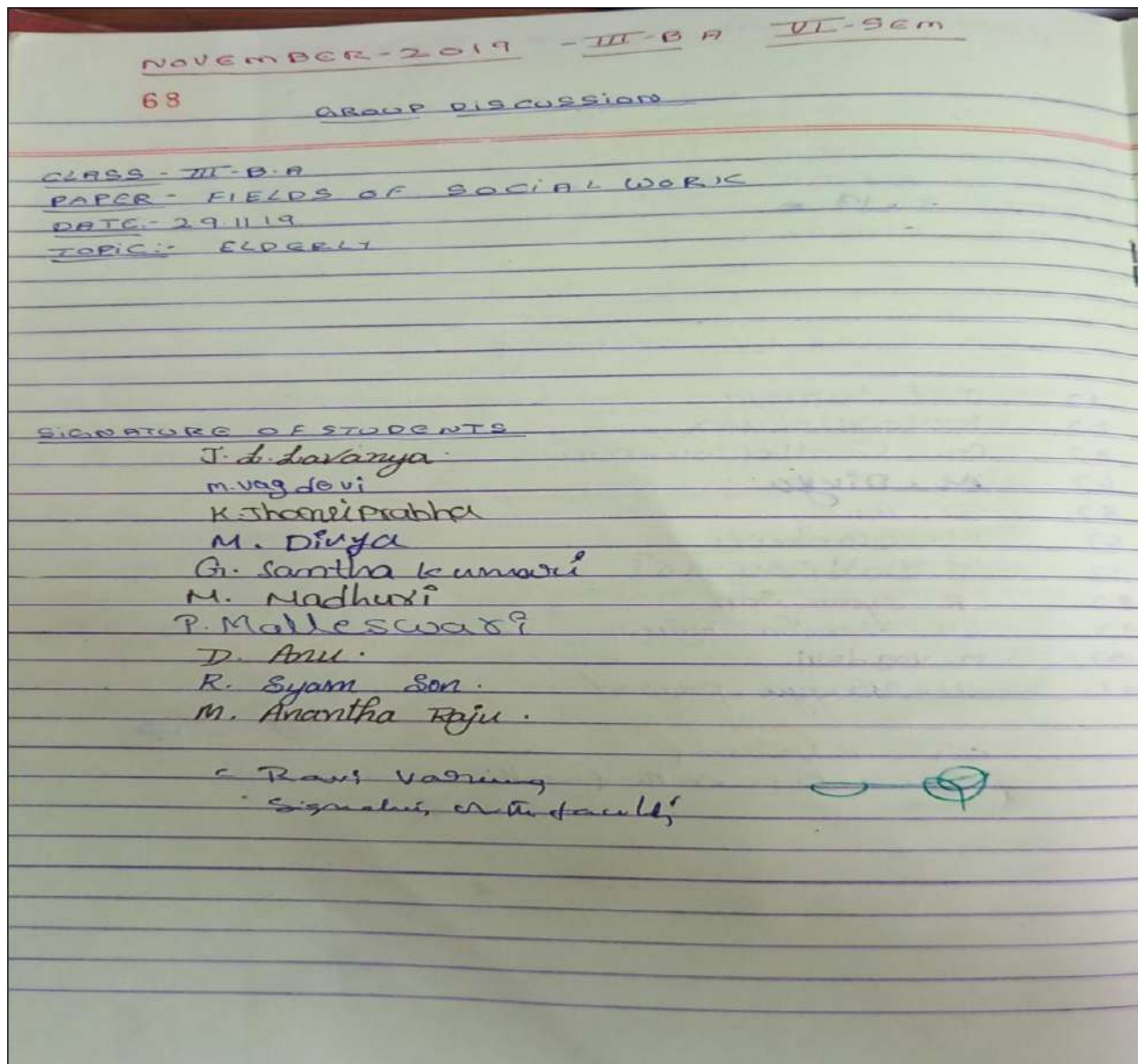


5. Group discussion on Elderly ,III BA : 29.11.19

Zoology Department conducted a field visit for III BZC students to Aqua expo at Siddartha College, Kanuru, Vijayawada. Field study is an essential part of the study of life science. Only classroom instructions cannot bring the all round development of the student. To widen the sphere of mental level of the student, they should be given a chance to get direct and firsthand experience to see the things themselves. To study animal in the natural environment where all the animals live in their natural habitat is one of the most interesting and useful experience for a student of Biology. This enhance the knowledge that we learnt from our classroom discussion and laboratory experiences in which we can observe , study and experience is quiet a good thing.

Another important aspect is apprehending knowledge of thing is always required for one of the start of a particular study. And one can hope to achieve experience of the interaction of the living thing with their environment from such field trip. In fact, classroom study and field study are supplementary to each other. It has also relief from daily classroom teaching when students spend a few hours in an informal atmosphere. It also motivates the students to learn science in their first hand and stimulates their interest. The scientific facts and principles become more realistic to the students when they see the relation between science and the society. Moreover students learn to co-operate amongst themselves and also with the member of the community. As a result it develops the power of critical thinking so that they apply element of scientific method. Lastly but not the least, it develops leadership and self confidence in the student.

Keeping all these in view and for partial fulfilment of our syllabus, Zoology department took keen interest in organising such study tour for students.

On September 29th, 2019, Dr. V Srinivas Rao conducted a guest lecture on "Modern Physics" at S CH V P M R Government Degree College in Ganapavaram. for B.Sc students, The lecture was aimed at providing an introduction to the latest developments in physics, including topics such as quantum mechanics, relativity, and particle physics.

A Just-A-Minute session was organized on 17.09.2019 for II Bcom and II BA students together on “Self Introduction”. The target of the program is to improve communication and presentation skills of the students. 13 students spoke for 2 minutes each, and on the whole, 46 students participated in the session. GD Srinivas, Dept. of English was the Resource person.

5. Remedial Coaching:

For the benefit of slow learners, remedial coaching classes were conducted from 14.10.19 to 21.10.19 after collecting feedback from students, and after observing midterm exams assessment. During the coaching, all important topics were revised and it was ensured that all such students attempted daily assignments in the class.

6. JAM Session

A Just-A-Minute session was organized on 19.12.2019 for II BSc students on “My Village”. The target of the program is to improve communication and presentation skills of the students. 17 students spoke for 2 minutes each, and on the whole, 42 students participated in the session. GD Srinivas, Dept. of English was the Resource person.

7. Group Discussion

A Group Discussion (GD) was organized for I year students on 31.01.2020 with a view to improving the students’ confidence in communication and developing their communication skills. The topic of the GD is “Reservations in Education”. Seven speakers were observed putting forward their views while others
