Resource Person: Sri B. Srinivasa Rao, Lecturer in Economics, CSTS GDC,

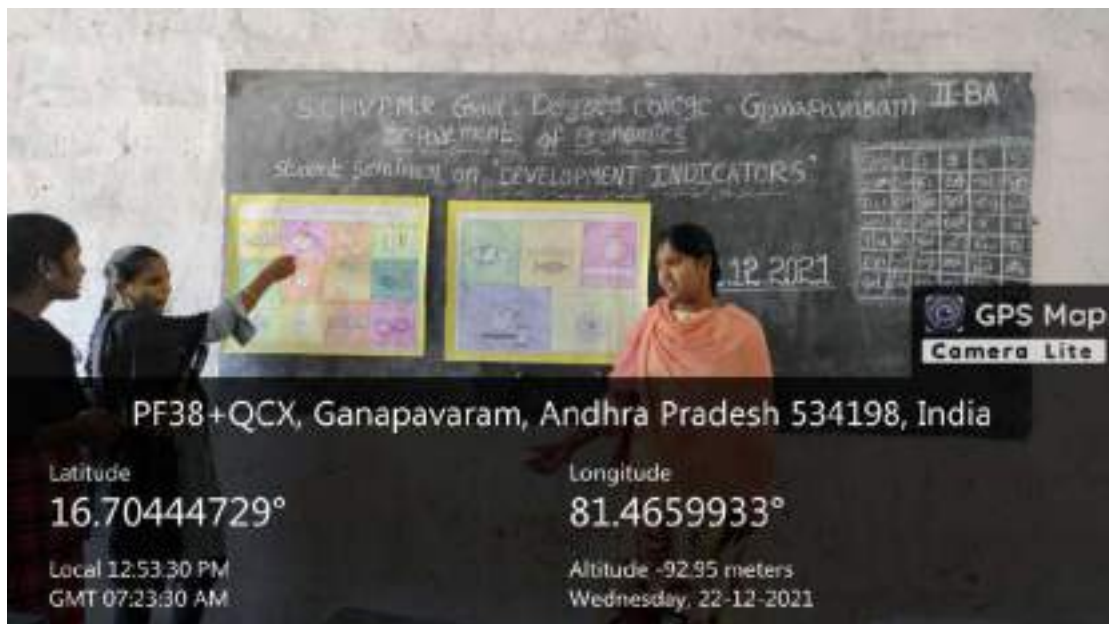
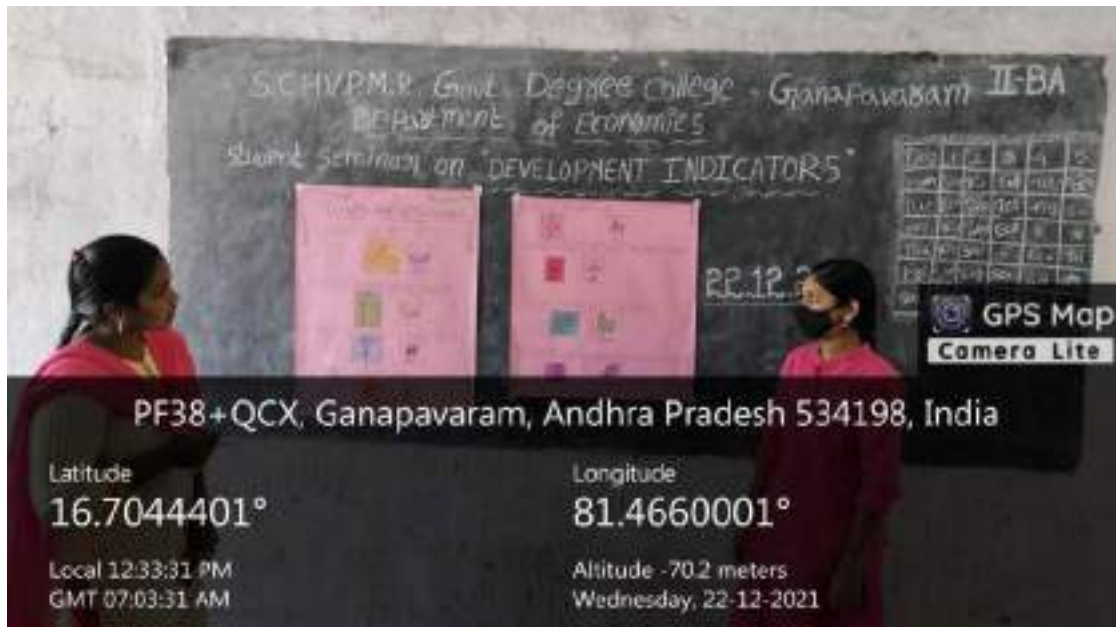
Jangareddygudem. He gave detailed lecture on achievements of new economic policy and its future prospects. Students interacted with resource person at the end and clarified their doubts.

❖ **Group Discussion on 21.02.2022**

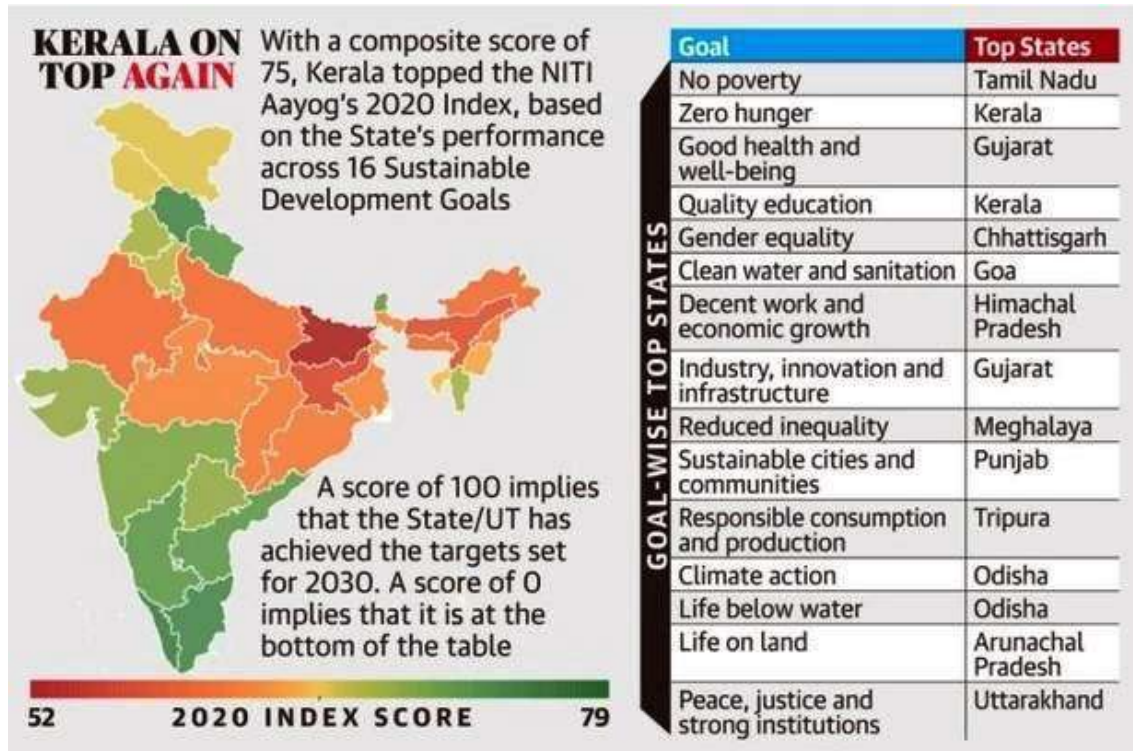

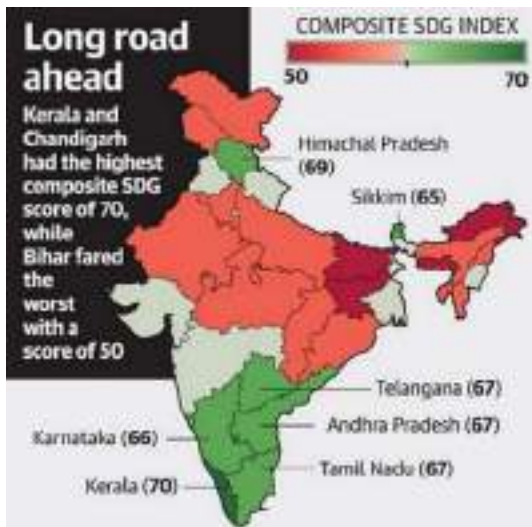


❖ **Status Study and Analysis of SDG India Index on 22.02.2022**

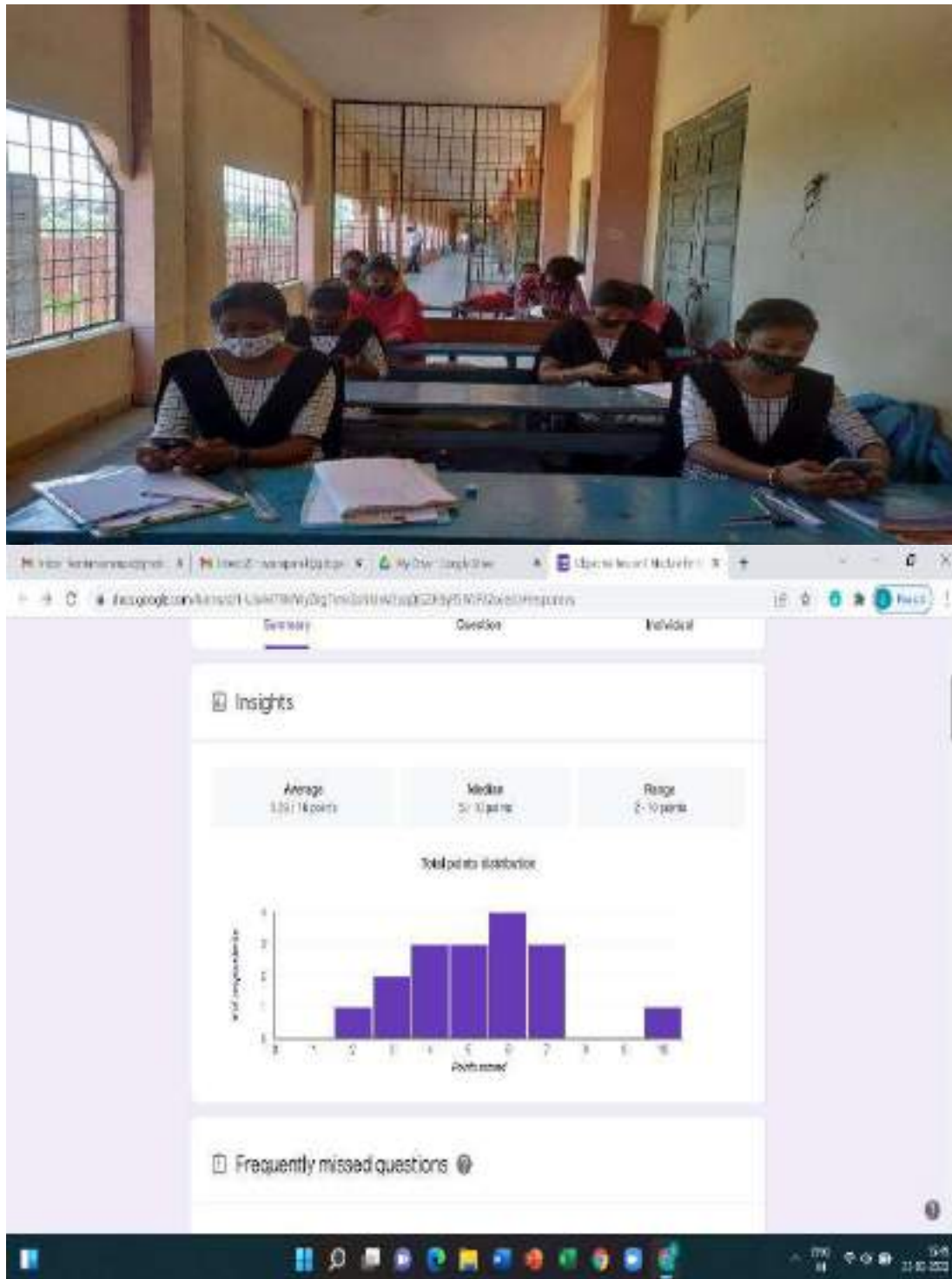

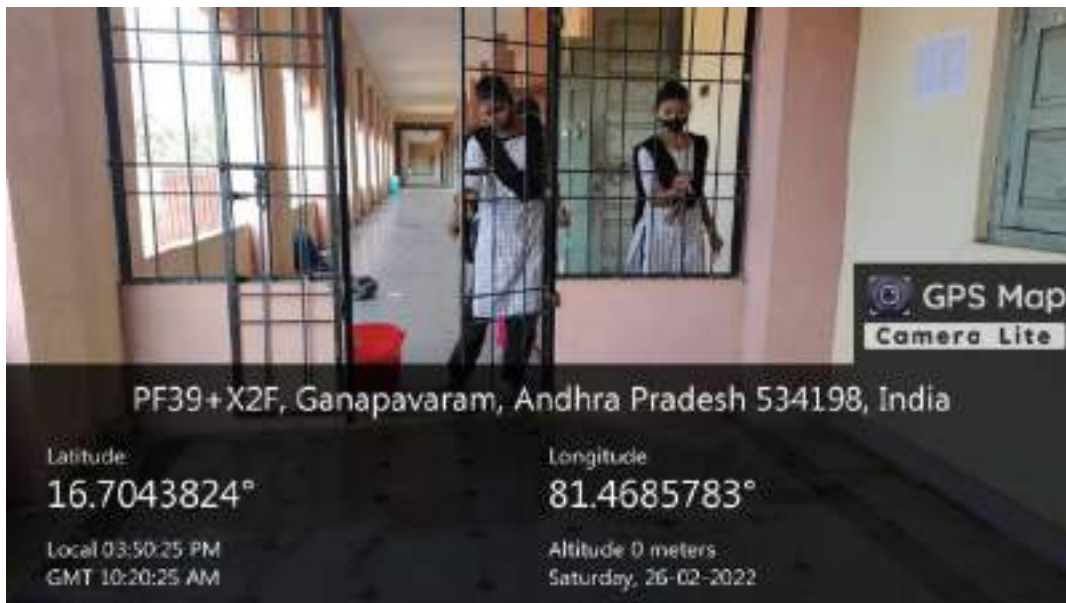
❖ Objective Test on 25.02.2022

As a part of internal assessment, I BA students dusted and mopped the classroom.

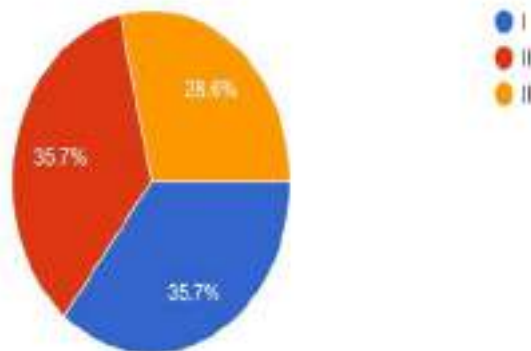


❖ Online Quiz on 02.03.2022

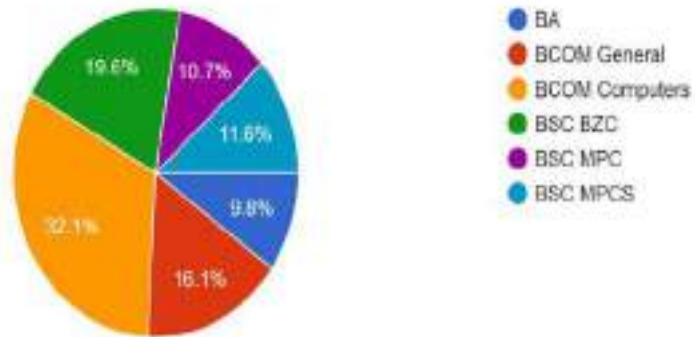

📊 Insights



❖ Student study Project from 14.03.2022 to 24.03.2022

A student study project was conducted for I and II BA students on “Advertisements”. They have the concept of market structures in their syllabus. Among the different types of market structures, monopolistic competition and oligopoly are most happening structures today in which advertising of a product is an important feature. Hence it is relevant to study the nature of advertisements to make students understand the types, advantages, disadvantages, importance, competition etc. For this, a predefined questionnaire was given to students to collect some inputs. Students participated well and collected, tabulated and analysed the inputs.



- **Major Findings**

- In almost all the advertisements, movie actors and sports persons are used to attract consumers as they have a greater number of followers.
- Ten advertisements show non price competition, two advertisements show price competition and remaining two shows both price and non-price competition. It clearly shows the dominance of product differentiation in marketing strategies.

- The products in the sample which belong to the oligopoly market are 12.5 percent and remaining 87.5 percent belong to monopolistic competition.
- All the advertisements are competitive in nature and no advertisement is only informative.
- Low price and high quality have no room in advertising and the only thing is to attract consumers with dialogues, appearance of actors, locations etc. and
- The new trend has changed to organic inputs like salt in toothpaste, aloe vera in shampoo and soaps etc.

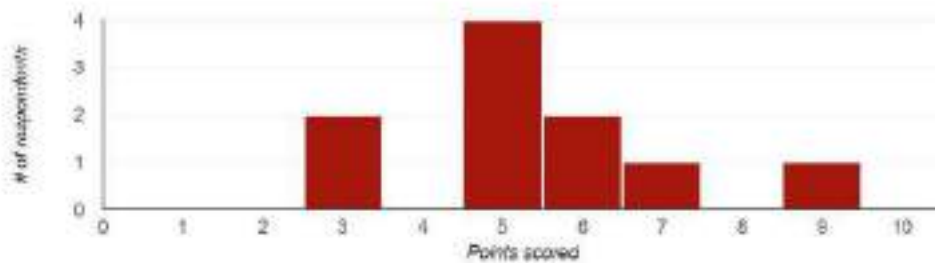

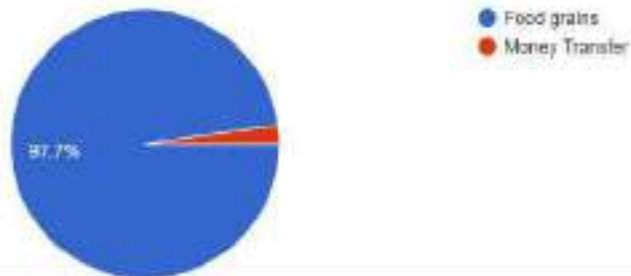

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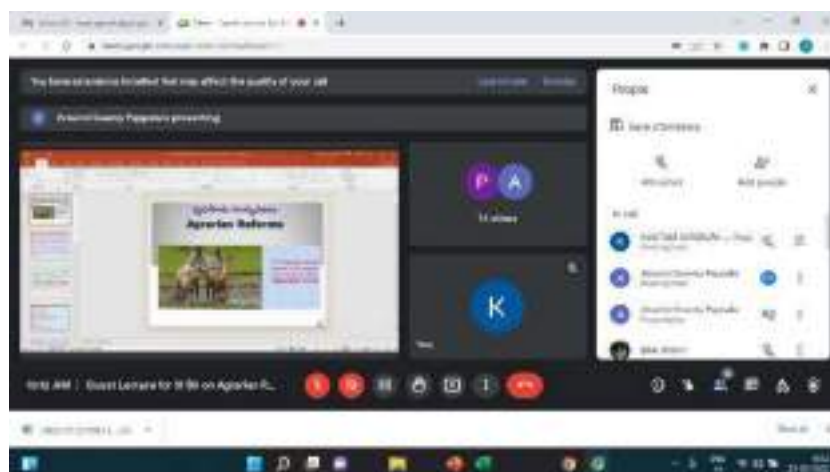
❖ CID Session 3 on 30.04.2022

❖ Student Seminar on 30.06.2022

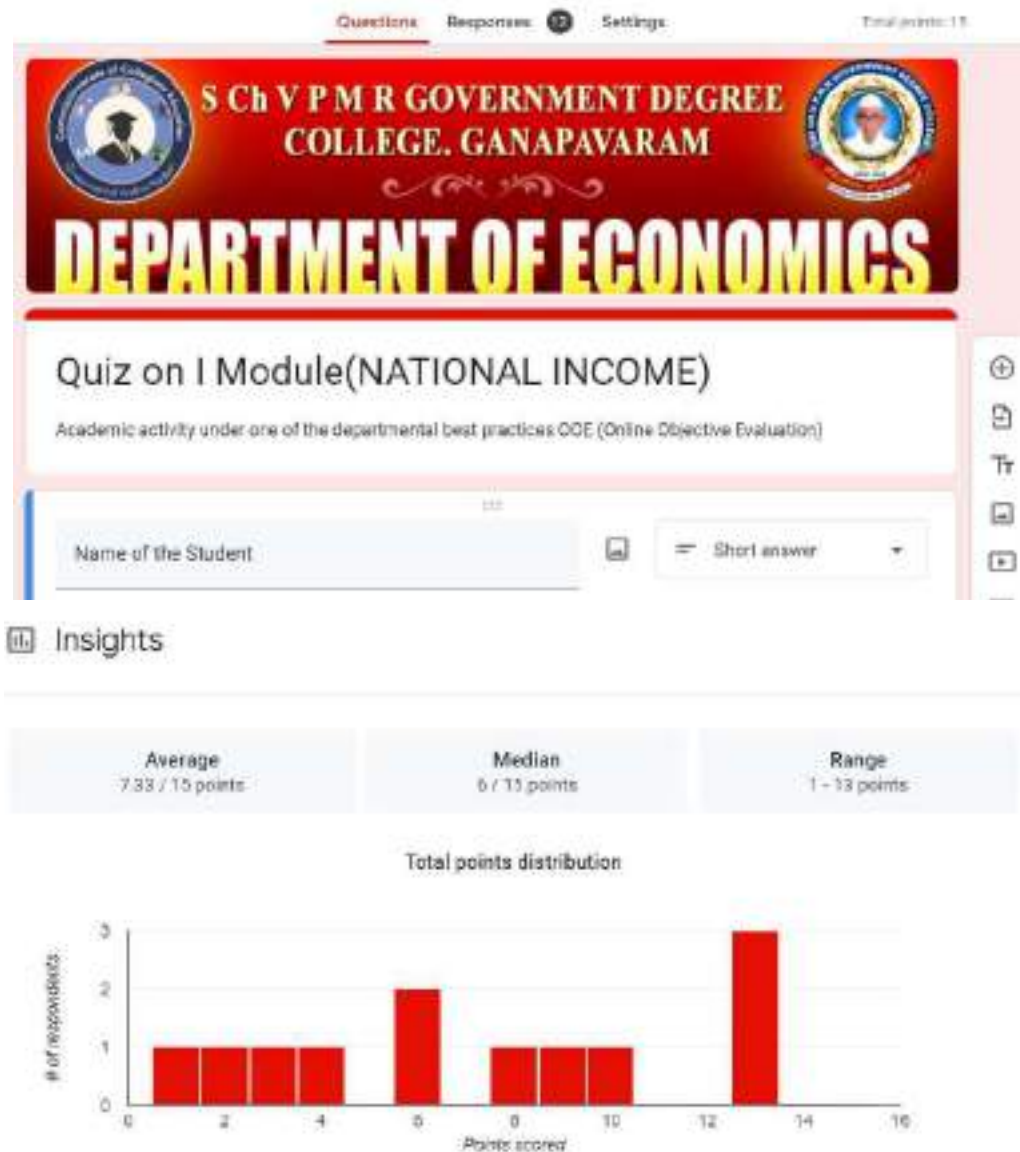

❖ **Collage Making for II BA**

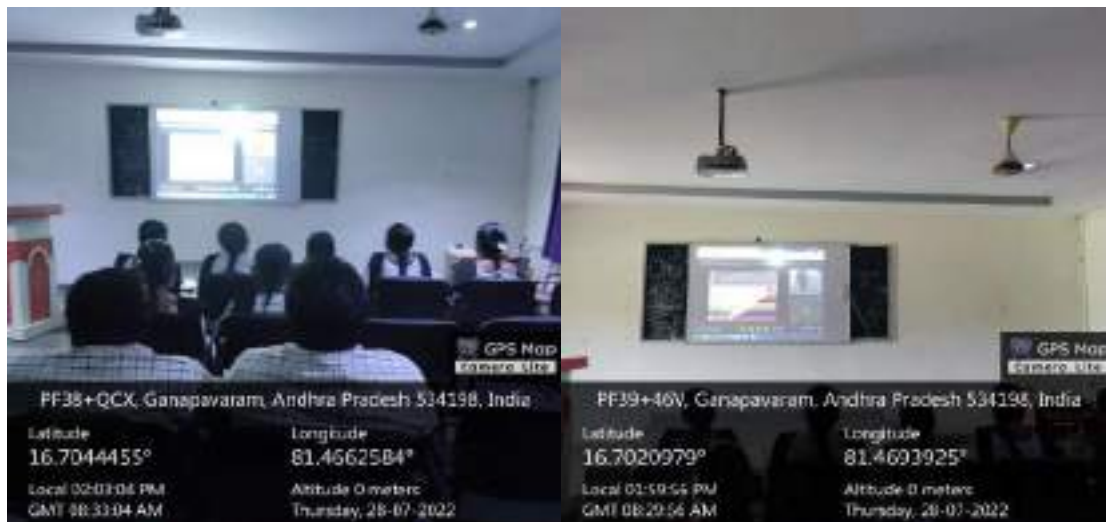

❖ Online Objective Test on II Module for I BA

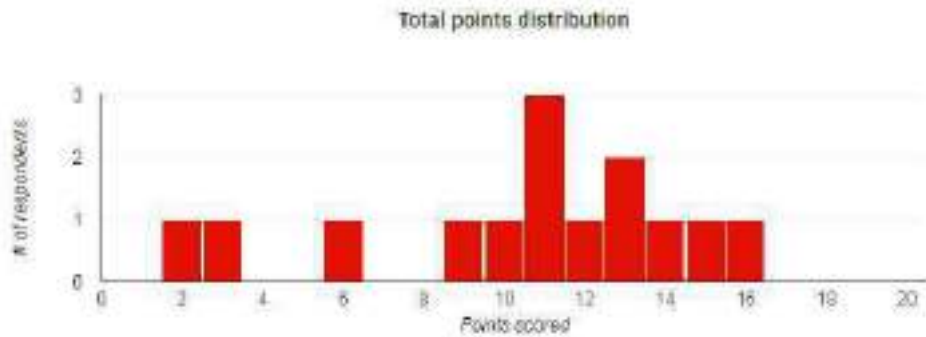

- Majority of the students want question papers in both TM and EM

I.Ravindranath Tagore Jayanthi

Rabindranath Tagore (7 May 1861 – 7 August 1941) was a Bengali polymath who worked as a poet, writer, playwright, composer, philosopher, social reformer and painter. He reshaped Bengali literature and music as well as Indian art with Contextual Modernism in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. Author of the "profoundly sensitive, fresh and beautiful" poetry of Gitanjali, he became in 1913 the first non-European and the first lyricist to win the Nobel Prize in Literature.

Tagore's poetic songs were viewed as spiritual and mercurial; however, his "elegant prose and magical poetry" remain largely unknown outside Bengal. He was a fellow of

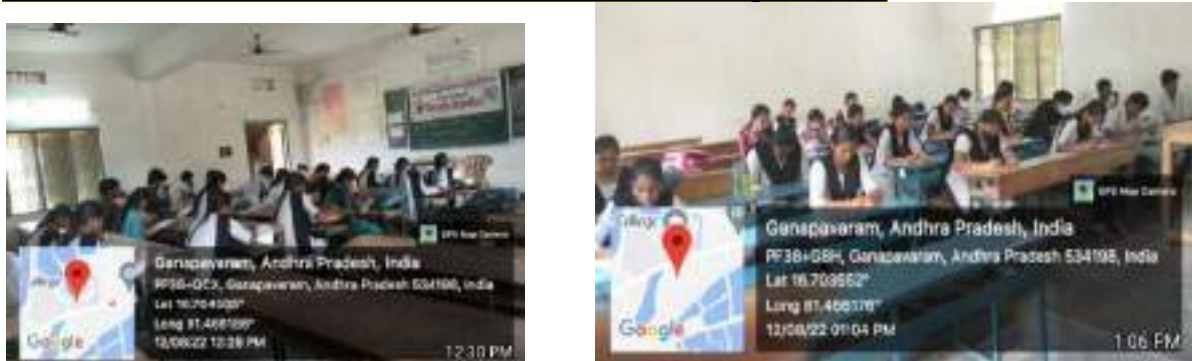

II.TEACHER'S DAY CELEBRATIONS

Dr.Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, (born Sept. 5, 1888, Tiruttani, India—died April 16, 1975, Madras [now it's called Chennai]). He was a Grate Scholar and statesman who was president of India from 1962 to 1967. He served as professor of philosophy at Mysore (1918–21) and Calcutta (1921–31; 1937–41) universities and as vice chancellor of Andhra University (1931–36). He was professor of Eastern religions and ethics at the University of Oxford in England (1936–52) and vice chancellor of Benares Hindu University (1939–48) in India. From 1953 to 1962 he was the chancellor of the University of Delhi.



Radhakrishnan led the Indian delegation to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO; 1946–52) and was elected chairman of UNESCO's executive board (1948–49). From 1949 to 1952 he served as Indian ambassador to the Soviet Union. On his return to India in 1952 he was elected vice president, and on May 11, 1962, he was elected president, succeeding Rajendra Prasad, who was the first president of independent India. Radhakrishnan retired from politics five years later.

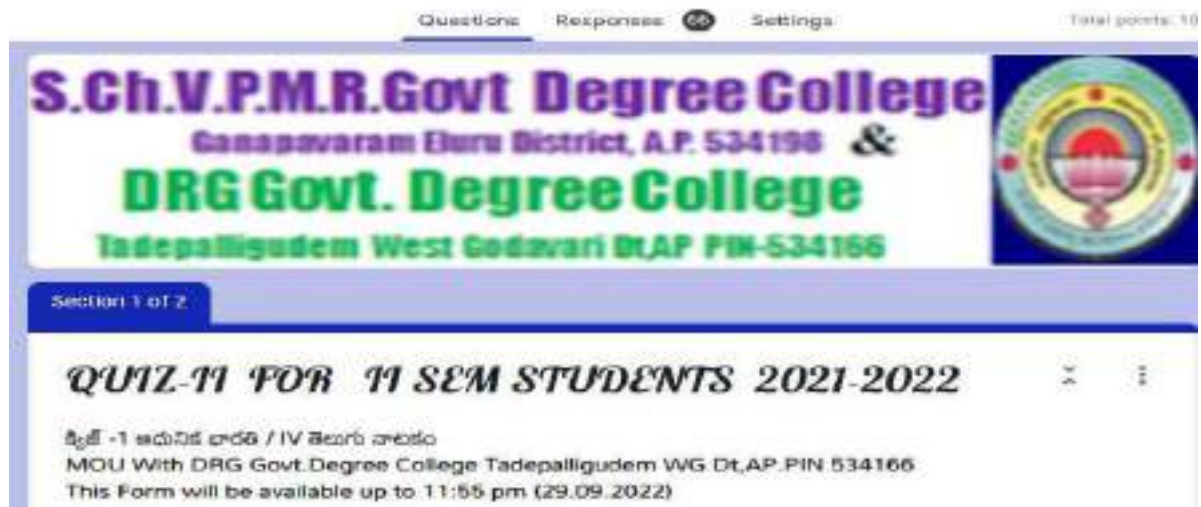

Boi Bheemanna is a poet who was born in a remote village to a Dalit family and has been awarded the Central Sahitya Akademi award and the Along with poverty, Bheemanna experienced [evils](#) like [untouchability](#) from childhood. Naturally he protested these. [Ambedkar](#) 's book on [caste eradication](#) was translated into [Telugu](#) .

IX. Kavikokila Gurram Jashuva Jayanti

Joshua was born on September 28 , 1895 to GurramVeeraya and Lingamma in Chatragadpadu, Vinukonda Mandal , Guntur District , Andhra Pradesh . Parents belong to different castes. His father was a Yadav, his mother was a Madiga, and his father worked as a pastor.This one thing is enough to face insults and slander in a society full of superstitions. Childhood passed comfortably in the green fields of Vinukonda village. After entering school to study, Joshua began to struggle. He faced many insults from teachers and fellow children.



But Joshua was not one to rest, but one to turn. If the upper caste children taunted them in the name of caste, he turned around and beat them. He married Mary in 1910. He used to work in a missionary school on a salary of three rupees per month. After losing that job, he went to Rajahmundry and worked there as a film reader in 1915-16. In those days when there were no talkies , this task was to read the story and dialogues in the background according to the story happening on the screen. community. Gradually he turned towards atheism .

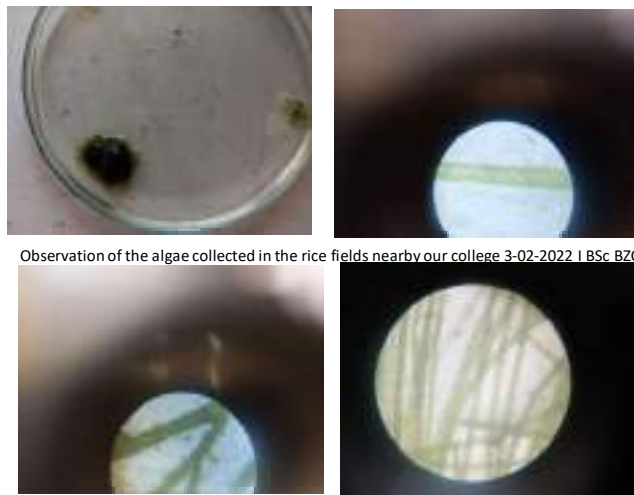
REPORT ON QUIZ COMPETITION

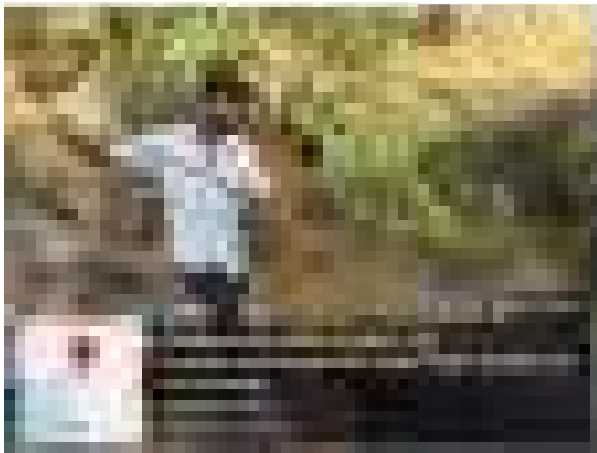

1) NATIONAL MATHEMATICS DAY ON 22-12-2021

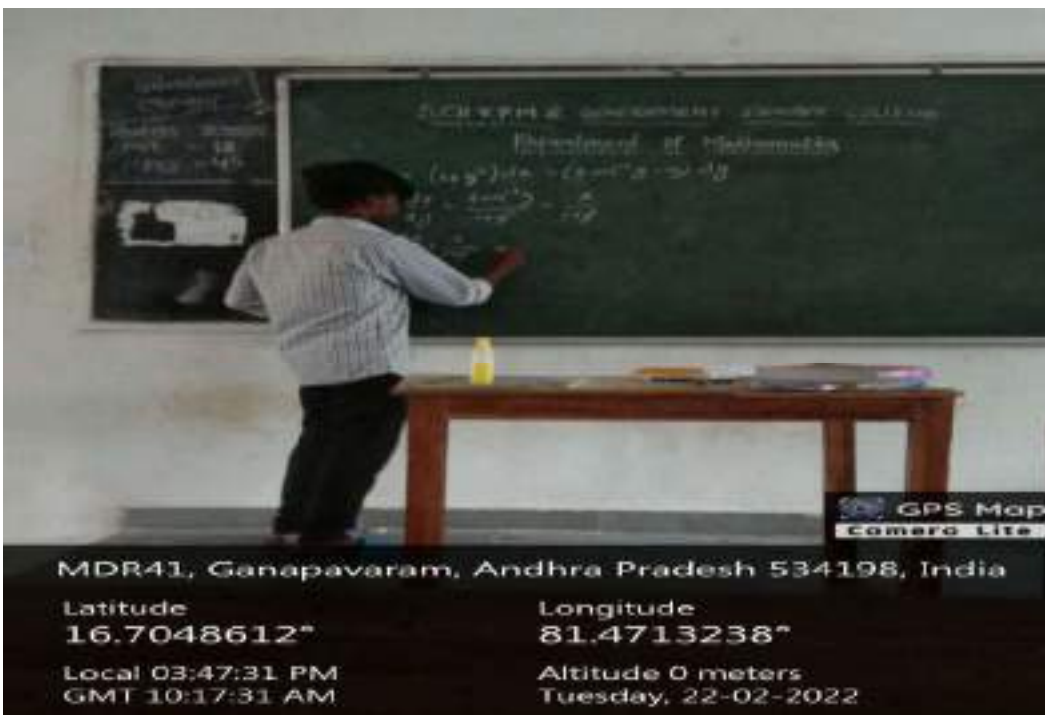

Topic: Stokes theorem, Rank-Nullity theorem

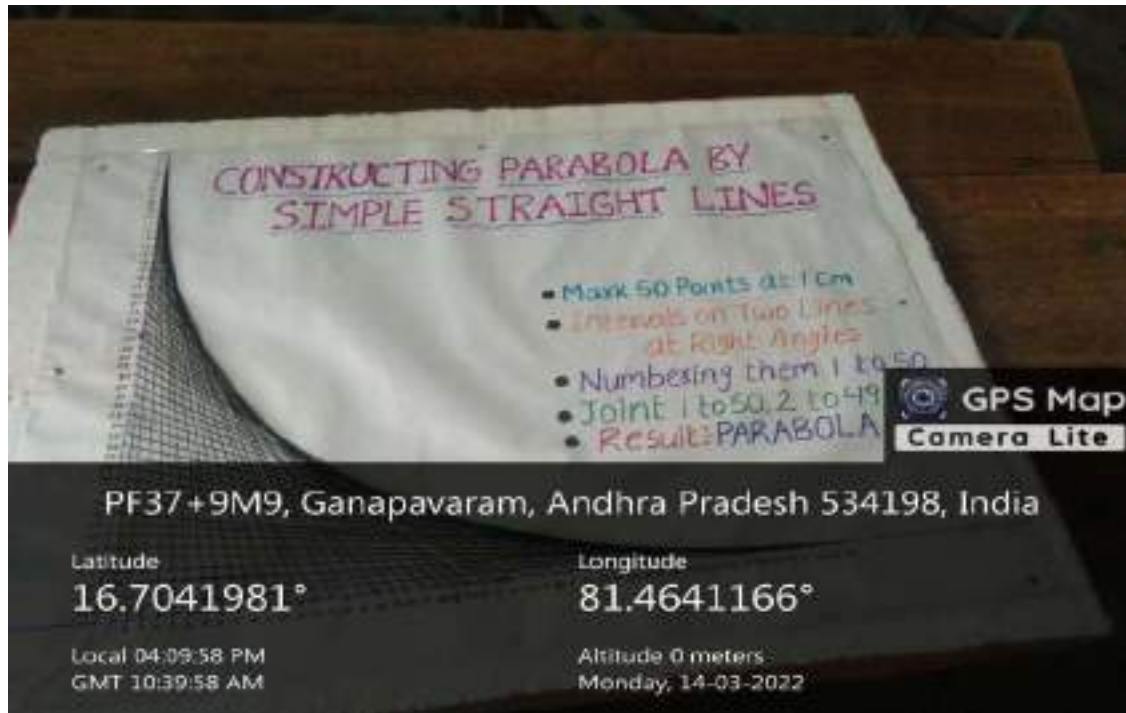
Two students explained two different theorems with statement and proof. Students explained the stokes theorem well and remaining students understood easily. They know about the importance of Rank-Nullity theorem.
