


Feed Back.

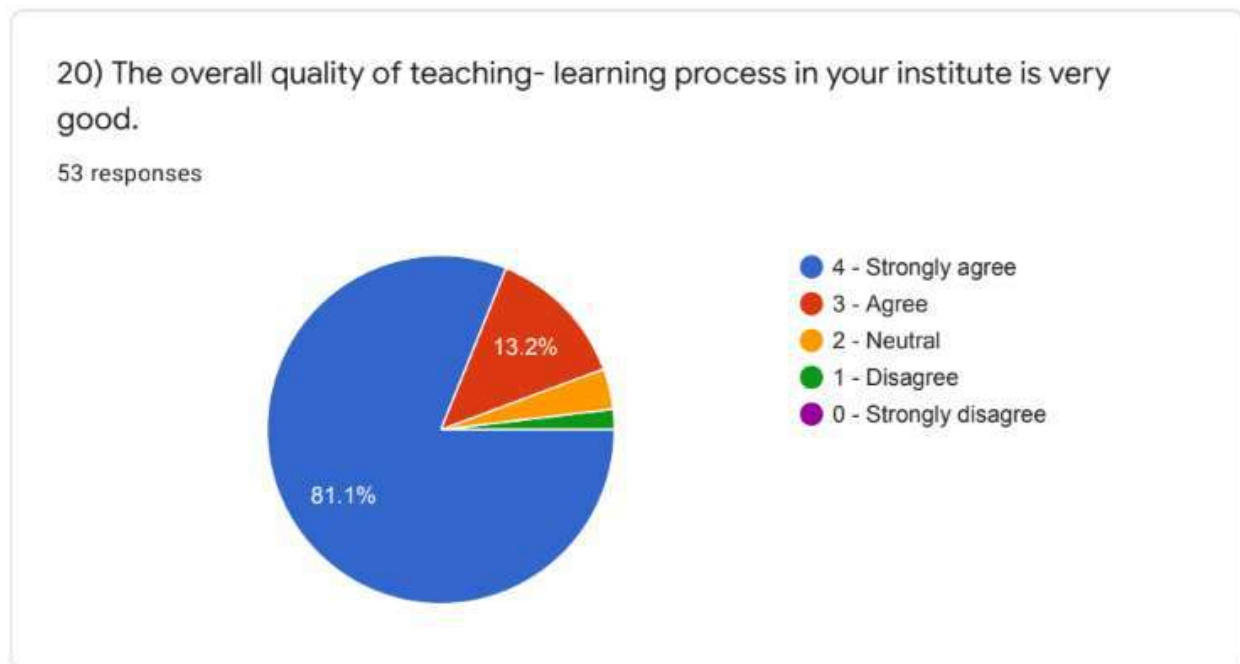

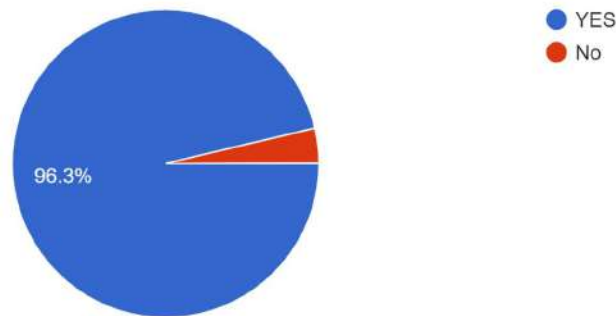


The feedback was placed before the College Planning and Development Council on 15.02.2022 and discussed the measures to be taken.

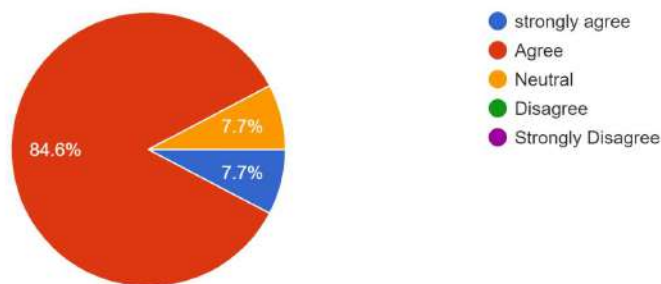

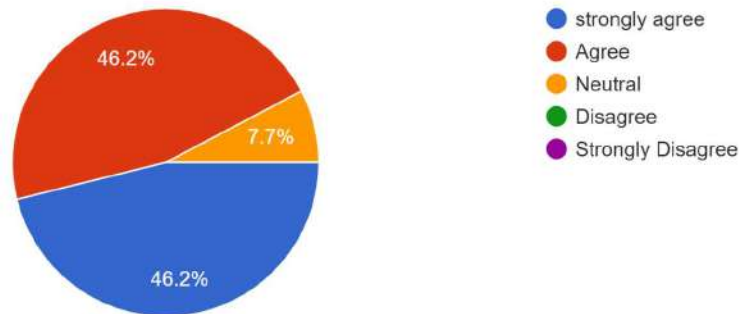
