#### Feedback Report - 2018-19

For the year 2018-19, feedback on the College functioning including teaching learning process was collected from the students, parents, teachers and alumni in offline mode. Students feedback form contains 20 questions and other stakeholders form contains 10 questions.

Fifty five students submitted their feedback which was collected by the class mentors. Before collection, the purpose of feedback was explained to the students. If the students could not understand any parameter, the mentors explained the parameter and its importance. With the help of the faculty, the IQAC arranged for the analysis of the collected data; the analysis was tabulated and also presented in a graphical format. The analysis report reveals that:

- Above 95% of students felt very happy with the syllabus completion, and student centered learning practices adapted in the college.
- Students between 10 to 20% were unhappy about organizing field visits, discussing latest developments, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities
- About 95% of the students were happy about remedial coaching, evaluation, and teachers' regularity to classes.
- Between 90 to 95% of students expressed their satisfaction with career counseling, personal care, and teachers accessibility outside the class.
- However, almost 95% of students expressed their happiness about the overall teaching learning process.

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

## Analysis of Alumni Responses








