On behalf of the staff and students of S.Ch.V.P.M.R.Govt Degree College, Ganapavaram, I am privileged to present the Annual Report of the institution encapsulating the significant events and achievements of the institution on the eve of 49th College Annual Day.

The institution was established in the year 1972 under the management of Sri Chintalapati Bapiraju Dharma Samstha by Sri Chintalapati Varaprasada Murthy Raju, a true Gandhian Philosopher and ex-minister of Andhra Pradesh. The institution has been playing a pivotal role in imparting higher education to the students of nearly 20 villages in and around Ganapavaram since its inception. The college left no stone unturned in the incessant pursuit of its vision and mission by the effective utilization of the available resources with utmost commitment. Having been bestowed with 2f & 12(b) status, the college has the opportunity to accelerate the academic and infrastructure development by seeking funds from UGC and applying for Minor /Major Research projects and National/ State level seminars.

Admissions and Results

In this academic year, a total 149 students were enrolled in first year into the six undergraduate programmes offered by the institution. The institution has a total student strength of 363 with 221 girls and 142 boys, hailing from various remote and backward villages in and around Ganapavaram to fulfill their dreams of higher education through the six undergraduate courses offered by the institution.

Certificate Courses under JKC Platform

In addition to the above certificate courses from the departments, four certificate courses entitled “English Communication Skills”, “Soft Skills”, “Analytical Skills” and “Computer skills” are introduced by the College respectively. The Certificate Course on “English Communication Skills” is of 35 hours duration and started with a student enrolment of 84. The main objective of this certificate course is to improve the English language skills of the students and make them compete for jobs in the globalized world.

IBM P TECH Courses

The Institution assesses the learning levels of the students through continuous internal evaluation; it encourages advanced learners to take up online courses. During 2020-21, 36 students registered in IBM P-Tech Online Courses and 20 of them completed 74 short term online Courses with a maximum of 6 courses each.
