#### **Certificate course on Digital Marketing**




## Certificate Course on "Financial Literacy"

#### Certificate Course on "Public Finance - India"




## **Certificate course on Reading Skills**


## Certificate course on Logical & Reasoning Ability


## Certificate course on Basic Statistics for Data Analysis

Students will create quantitative models to solve real world problems in appropriate context.





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



## Certificate Course on "Light Microscopy"




