Student Scholarships - Policy and Procedure



Purpose:

Scholarships at SCHVPMR GOVT. DEGREE COLLEGE are disbursed by the state government of Andhra Pradesh to reach out to the students from socially and economically weaker sections i.e., SC, ST, OBC, & KAPU community and differently abled students. Unreached sections yet aspiring to progress in life shall be given opportunity to grow through these scholarships.

Eligibility:

All the students who have joined graduation at SCHVPMR GOVT. DEGREE COLLEGE, Ganapavaram belonging to SC, ST, BC, Kapu, and differently-abled categories are eligible for the state government scholarships.

Schemes:

The government of AP disburses scholarships to the students pursuing graduation under "JAGANANNA VIDYA DEEVENA" & "JAGANANNA VASATHI DEEVENA" schemes.

YS Jaganmohan Reddy, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh has initiated the Vasathi Deevena scheme of financial educational assistance to students for various courses in the state of AP. **Jagananna Vasathi Deevena** Scheme intends to help students from low-income group families who are good in their academic studies. The scholarship will help the students to carry on education and to become successful people in the future. The amount of scholarships is Rs 20,000 pa for UG students under this scheme.

Education is a fundamental right that every child should have access to, regardless of their background or financial situation. In Andhra Pradesh, the **Jagananna Vidya Deevena scheme** was introduced by the state government to provide financial assistance to eligible students who want to pursue higher education. Jagananna Vidya Deevena is a fee reimbursement scheme for all students who are pursuing ITI, Polytechnic, Degree, Engineering and Medicine in the state. This is to help the minority and less privileged students.

The Institution ensures that all eligible students under these two schemes get benefitted by these scholarships. After the admission process is completed, the office initiates the online application process through Jnanabhumi portal which is connected to and monitored by the welfare departments in the state.

The amount is usually transferred to the student's mother bank account which is registered in Jnanabhumi portal at the time of admission or application for scholarship. The amount is disbursed in four quarters usually. If any student doesn't receive a scholarship amount, the office staff will correspond with the welfare departments and ensure that no eligible student is deprived of the opportunity.
