Sub:-Government Degree Colleges – Introduction of new post graduate programmes and enhancement of seats and discontinuation of programmes in Government Degree Colleges from the Academic year 2024-25 – Orders – Issued.

Ref:- 1. Proposals received from the Principals of Government Degree Colleges.
2. U.O.Note No.2/APCCE-Acad Cell/AC-09/2024, dated 22.05.2024.

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In the reference 1stcited, proposals have been received from the Principals of Government Degree Colleges in the State with request to accord necessary permission to start new post graduate programmes, enhancement of seats in existing programmes and discontinuation of existing Post Graduate programmes from the academies year 2024-25.

After through examining the said proposals, in consultation with academicians and on ascertaining the local demand, viability of New P.G courses after induction in the Colleges, as mentioned against each College, the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Mangalagiri is hereby accorded necessary permission to start new Post Graduate programmes in addition to the existing courses with the intake as mentioned against each PG Course.

Further the Commissioner of Collegiate Education AP Mangalagiri is permitted to discontinuation of existing programmes in Government Degree Colleges from the academies year 2024-25 as mentioned in the Annexures enclosed.

The above new Post Graduate Programmes now sanctioned are without any additional financial commitment to the Government either now or in future subject to the following conditions.

1. The sanctioned Post Graduate Programmes are on self finance basis.
2. No additional posts will be sanctioned for the newly started Post Graduate Programmes.
3. No additional funds will be provided for building, equipment and other infrastructural facilities.
4. The existing Labs, Equipment, man power etc., shall be utilized for the newly started P.G. Programme.
5. The expenditure on salaries of the staff of Post Graduate Programmes shall be met from the additional special fee collected from the students.
6. The fee structure and expenditure procedure shall be as per the affiliating University rules and orders of the Commissioner issued from time to time.

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7. Necessary steps should be taken for mapping of the fee structure with the concerned Social Welfare Departments viz SC, S.T, B.C for sanction of the Scholarships to the admitted Students in consultation with the affiliated University.
8. Necessary affiliation from the concerned University should be obtained and ensure that the said courses are started from the academic year 2024-25. The receipt of the proceedings should be acknowledged.
