

Rising Enrollment: A Positive Growth in Admissions






Academic Performance 2023-24




2023-24 Semester Wise & Programme Wise Pass Percentage

Empowering Growth: Financial Assistance and Infrastructure Development


The institution was selected for financial assistance under **Infrastructural Grants to Colleges** as part of **RUSA 2.0**, a prestigious initiative aimed at strengthening higher education institutions. Under this scheme, a **sanctioned amount of ₹2 crore** was allocated to enhance infrastructure and academic resources. So far, **₹1,05,42,817** has been effectively utilized for key developmental projects, significantly improving the learning environment and facilities on campus. This funding has played a crucial role in fostering academic excellence and providing students with better resources to support their educational journey.

Specifically, ₹51,30,817 has been allocated for the **construction of 7 new classrooms** and a **state-of-the-art auditorium**, which are currently in progress. Additionally, an amount of **₹54,12,000** has been strategically invested in **50 desktop computers, 4 smart boards, and 2 interactive panels**, enhancing digital infrastructure and creating a more dynamic and engaging learning environment for our students.. The renovation of existing facilities is yet to commence, but the planned developments will further strengthen the college's capacity to cater to the growing needs of its student population.

Bridging Academia and Industry: Internships for Skill Development

Our college has actively collaborated with various industries and organizations to provide students with valuable short-term and semester internships during the academic year 2023-24. Key partners include **Tata Wistron**, Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC), Krishi Vignan Kendra-Undi, TWL Aqua Diagnostic Centre, PACS Ganapavaram, and Skill Dzire, offering hands-on experience in diverse sectors. Notably, 12 students attended a **prestigious short-term internship at Tata Wistron in Kolar, Karnataka**, earning a stipend of ₹12,000 per month 15.05.2024 to 14.07.2024. The institution entered into MoUs with these industries to facilitate inculcation of skills to students.

In total, **64** students completed short-term internships and **106** students successfully completed semester-long internships gaining practical skills and industry exposure essential for their future careers.
