



Report on World Rabies Day

The Department of Zoology, SCHVPMR Government Degree College, Ganapavaram organized an awareness program on the occasion of World Rabies Day on 28th September 2025. The program aimed to raise awareness among students and faculty regarding the causes, prevention, and control of rabies — a fatal yet 100% preventable zoonotic disease that continues to pose a global public health challenge.

The event was inaugurated by Dr. P. Nirmala Kumari, Principal, who addressed the gathering and highlighted the importance of responsible pet vaccination, timely medical attention after animal bites, and community-level education in eradicating rabies. Vice Principal Dr. K. Swarupa Rani elaborated on the global theme of World Rabies Day 2025 and its relevance in today's context. Faculty members including Sri K.V.
