**Sub:-** Collegiate Education – to organize orientation programme for Intermediate passing out students and to conduct "Open-Day" in the first week of February-2026-Reg.

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In order to attract/motivate the students to join Government Degree Colleges, the GDCs shall conduct orientation programmes to the passing out students of Junior Colleges and organize an 'Open-Day' during the first week of February, 2026.

The GDCs shall,

- Identify the Junior Colleges in the vicinity of each Government Degree College and map the Students & faculty to Junior Colleges.
- Organize a student rally to the Junior Colleges in their vicinity (15/20 students as a batch depending on the strength of the college) along with the teaching staff.
- Display posters/distribute pamphlets to explain the available courses, infrastructure facilities, training and placement drives conducted, student's/faculty achievements to orient the final year students
- Invite the students and faculty of Junior Colleges to visit Government Degree College on 'Open Day', to acquaint themselves with facilities available at GDCs and the principals of GDCs are also informed to issue press notes well in advance with regard to 'Open-Day' to reach out more students.
- Create awareness on Single Major Programmes

On the 'Open Day' the GDCs have to facilitate the following for Junior College students and faculty:

- To visit the College Library and laboratories
- To visit to JKC centre and Computer Labs
- To visit departments and interaction with faculty and students
- Conduct practical sessions/hands on job experience in laboratories which will be useful for intermediate practical exams.
- Science exhibitions/poster presentations.
- Collection of feedback from the students on their choice of courses.
- Any other activity / event to showcase the potential of GDCs.
