Commissionerate of Collegiate Education (CCE), A.P in collaboration with Ratan Tata Innovation Hub (RTIH), has launched an initiative to encourage and support entrepreneurial ideas among students at Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) across the state.

In this regard, as part of RTIH-CCE Amaravati Pilot: Student Entrepreneurship Program, CCE has collected the details of Entrepreneurship Coordinators from all GDCs and communicated the same to RTIH. Subsequently, RTIH conducted orientation meetings with the Principals and Coordinators to outline the implementation framework.

The RTIH-CCE Amaravati Pilot has successfully completed Phase-1 (Faculty Orientation) and Phase-2 (Pre-Spark Online Course). Based on rigorous assignment-based evaluation, 60 students from Government Degree Colleges (GDCs) across Andhra Pradesh have been shortlisted with 40 students backup for the **Phase-3 Onsite Pre-Spark–cum–Spark 5-Day Intensive Bootcamp**, which will be conducted from **23rd February 2026 to 27th February 2026 at Ratan Tata Innovation Hub (RTIH), Mangalagiri.**

This **5-Day Intensive Bootcamp** represents a critical milestone in the entrepreneurship journey of selected students. The program is designed to transform classroom knowledge into practical entrepreneurial capability through intensive problem-solving, customer discovery, solution framing, and direct exposure to real startup ecosystems and mentors.

Program Focus: Problem identification and validation, customer discovery, solution framing, team dynamics, founder mindset development, and exposure to real startup journeys and mentors.

The Travel expenditure of Students and faculty accompanying them from their native places to RTIH and return journey to their native places may be met from any of the internal funds available at their colleges as per Government norms.

Mandatory Requirements

All selected students must bring:

1. **Personal Laptop** (fully charged with charger)
2. Government-issued photo identification (Aadhaar Card/College ID Card)
3. Medications (if any).
4. Any specific dietary requirements to be informed in advance

The **Selected cohort of 60 students** given by RTIH is provided as **Annexure - 1, Code of Conduct for students** is placed in **Annexure-2 Roles, and responsibilities** in **Annexure-3**.

This 5-Day Intensive Bootcamp represents a unique opportunity for selected students to develop entrepreneurial mindsets, validate innovative ideas, and embark on their startup journey with expert guidance. All stakeholders—students, faculty coordinators, and college administrations—must work in close coordination to ensure the program's success and maximize learning outcomes.

In this regard, all the Principals of participating Government Degree Colleges are directed to take immediate necessary action and ensure smooth implementation of Phase-3 Bootcamp as per the instructions detailed above.

Annexure – 2

Important Instructions and Code of Conduct

All selected students and accompanying faculty coordinators must strictly adhere to the following:

1. Students must report punctually on the 5th Floor of O/o CCE, A.P. on **23.02.2026 at 9:00 AM sharp** for accommodation. Late arrivals will not be accommodated.
2. This is a **mandatory residential intensive program**. Students must participate in all sessions throughout the 5-day duration. Partial participation will not be permitted.
3. **Attendance will be recorded daily** at RTIH. Digital RTIH Certificate of Completion will be issued ONLY to students with 100% attendance and satisfactory participation as assessed by RTIH mentors.
4. Students must maintain strict discipline and professional conduct throughout the program. Any misconduct, indiscipline, or violation of program rules will be viewed seriously.
5. Mobile phone usage during bootcamp sessions is strictly restricted. Phones must be kept silent and used only during designated break times.
6. Students must adhere to the accommodation facility rules, maintain cleanliness, and respect public property. Any damage to accommodation facilities will attract penalties.
7. Any misconduct may lead to immediate removal from the program.
8. Students must not leave the CCE or RTIH premises during the program without explicit permission from accompanying faculty coordinators.
9. Students are advised to inform their parents/guardians about this residential program and share emergency contact details with faculty coordinators.
10. Any medical emergencies or health issues must be immediately reported to accompanying faculty coordinators.
11. Students must respect the learning environment, collaborate positively with peers, and engage constructively with mentors and faculty.
12. **Violation of any program rules, code of conduct, or disciplinary norms will invite stringent action by the Commissioner of Collegiate Education**, including but not limited to:
 - Immediate removal from the bootcamp without certificate
 - Adverse entry in academic records
 - Reporting to parent institution for disciplinary proceedings
 - Debarring from future CCE programs and initiatives

Responsibilities of College Principals

All Principals of participating Government Degree Colleges are directed to:

1. **Immediately communicate** these proceedings to all shortlisted students from their respective colleges.
2. Ensure selected students **confirm their participation within two working days** (by 22.02.2026).
3. In case of any student's inability to participate, inform this office immediately (by 22.02.2026, 5:00 PM) so that backup candidates can be accommodated.
4. **Nominate and officially depute** at least one faculty coordinator to accompany students from their college for the entire 5-day duration.
5. Conduct a **mandatory pre-departure briefing** for all selected students covering program expectations, reporting instructions, code of conduct, disciplinary norms, and TA claim procedures.
6. Collect emergency contact details (parent/guardian name, mobile number, address) of all participating students and share with accompanying faculty coordinators.
7. Verify that all students have functional laptops before departure. Students without laptops will not be allowed to participate.
8. **Facilitate TA claims processing** from college internal funds for students upon return and submission of bills with supporting documents.
9. Ensure smooth coordination for student departure on 23.02.2026 and facilitate their safe return after program completion.
10. Submit **post-program feedback report** from participating students and faculty coordinators to this office within one week of program completion.
11. Monitor student conduct and discipline throughout the program through accompanying faculty coordinators.
12. Take appropriate action against any student from their college who violates program rules or code of conduct.
