As per the reference cited above ,the Government of Andhra Pradesh has designated the **3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of every month as Swachhata Day**, marking it as a state wide cleanliness day. As per the instructions received from the Swachha Andhra Corporation for the month of March 2026 , the Swachha Andhra Program is **rescheduled to 28-03-2026**.The theme for this month of **March 2026 theme-"Source Segregation and Zero Waste Lifestyles"** to promote responsible waste management practices among students and the community.

In this regard all the Principals of Government/Private Aided/Private Un Aided Degree Colleges are requested to organize the following theme based activities in the campus and in near by communities:

1. 100% Waste segregation in campus-Place separate bins for Wet Waste and Dry Waste in class rooms, corridors, canteen and hostels& also, ensure that the waste is collected without mixing.
2. Conduct awareness programs on topic Plastic free Environment. Encourage students and staff to use of steel bottles, cloth bags and reusable materials to reduce single use plastics to make Zero Waste campus initiative.
3. Set up small composting units for food waste generated from canteen and hostel and utilize the compost for College gardens and plants.
4. Organize seminars, poster making competitions, debates and awareness sessions on waste segregation and zero waste life styles.
5. Conduct campus cleanliness drives with NSS/NCC Volunteers and identify how much wet waste and dry waste is generated in the campus.
6. Display posters and signboards about waste segregation in important places in the campus.
7. Conduct community campaign~My Waste- My Responsibility to create awareness in the community, staff and students to take responsibility for their waste.
8. Instruct campus sanitation staff on proper segregation and collection of waste.
9. Upload all the activities on the respective colleges social media handles as well as on the official CHE Social media handles using Hashtags Ex:#APCHE, #GDCsSASA, #GDCs"**Source Segregation and Zero Waste Lifestyles**".

Hence all the Principals of Government/ Private Aided/Private Un Aided Degree Colleges are requested to encourage the students and staff to actively participate in the implementation of the March SASA activities under the theme :"**Source Segregation and Zero Waste Lifestyles**"on **28-03-2026**.
