To improve and maintain the academic standards and to create work culture in colleges, as per UGC 2010 regulations the Commissioner of Higher Education is collecting ASAR from Lecturers, Physical Directors and Librarians of both Government and Private Aided Colleges and AADPI from the Principals of Government Degree Colleges and Private Aided Colleges in the prescribed format available on the Website of APCHE.

The Lecturers, Physical Directors and Librarians of both Government and Aided Degree Colleges are informed to submit the ASAR in the prescribed format with relevant evidence to the IQAC of the college. The IQAC, after verifying the data submitted by the staff members will submit the evaluated score to the Principal of the college. The Principal of the College should verify, certify and upload the evaluated score on the CCE website through **College Login**.

The Principals of the GDCs & PACs are informed to submit the AADPIs with the relevant evidences to the RJDCE of the concerned Zone. The RJDCE after verifying the data submitted by the Principal will evaluate the score and upload the score on the CCE website through **RJDCE login**.

The ASARs / AADPIs are to be submitted for the academic year 2025-2026 **from 1st June 2025 to 31st May 2026**.

The last date for uploading the data on the CCE website is **31st July 2026**.
