# Online Quiz Commemorating World Environment Day-05.06.2026

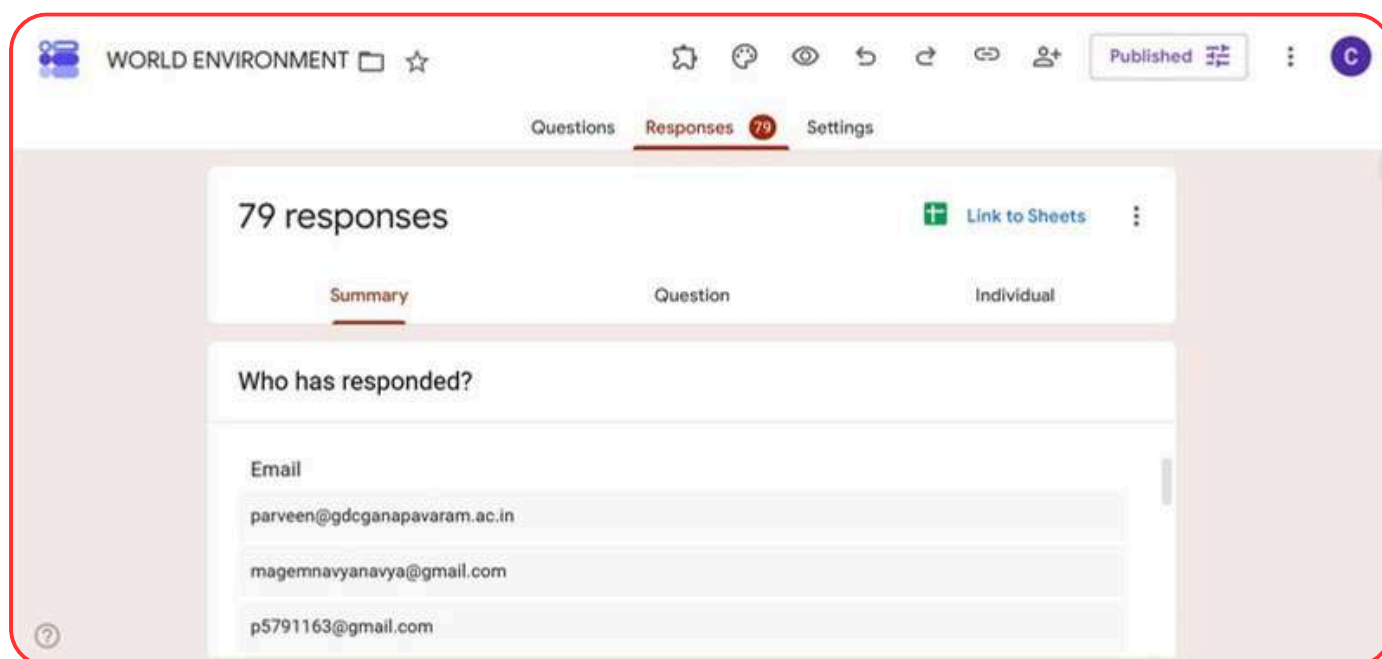

## SASA “Operation Clean Sweep” Activity Conducted- 20.06.2026

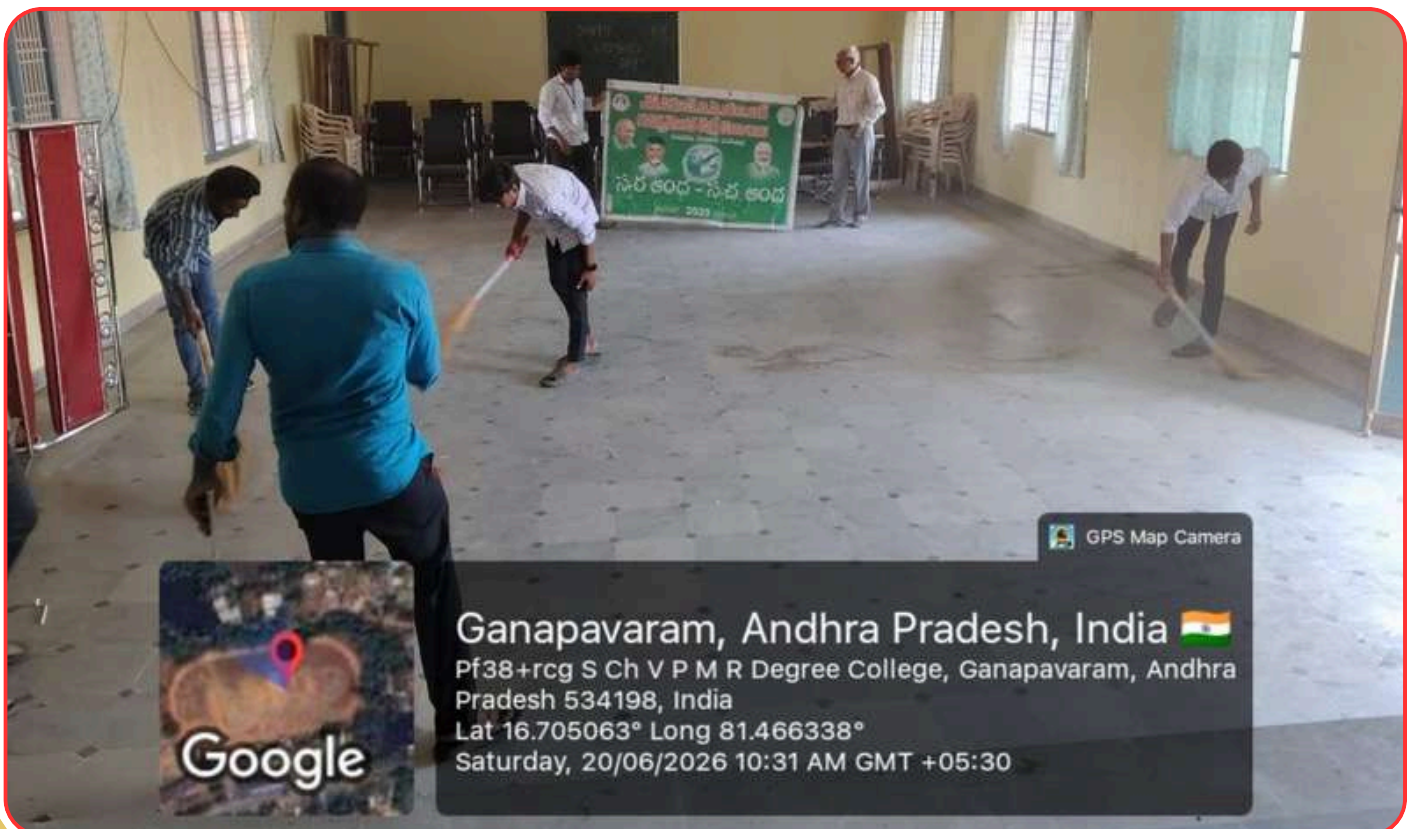

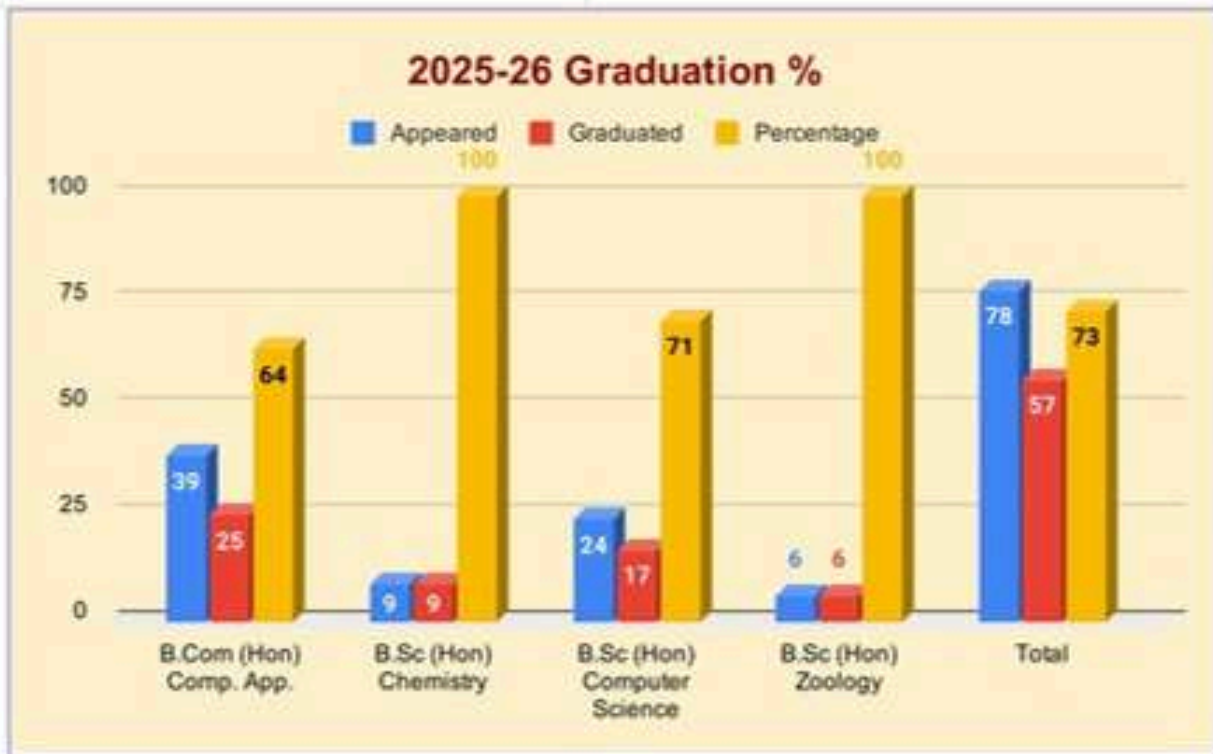
